




Big Oak Tree State Park Accessibility Information

The symbol  indicates that the specified area is fully compliant with Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG).

Picnic Area

This area is located on your left just after the park sign. Large trees, including two state champions, shade this area. A level, paved parking lot has one handicap space near the shelter. Here, a pathway leads past an information kiosk to the shelter, which accommodates 78 people and has two group grills, extended-end tables and a water fountain. Two paved picnic sites are located near the accessible playground and have extended-end tables and pedestal grills. A water fountain and bench are also located here for your convenience. An accessible vault toilet is provided nearby.

Interpretive Center and Boardwalk

A gravel lot has a paved apron with an accessible water fountain. Here, the boardwalk begins with an informational kiosk. The interpretive center is located among the trees with railed steps to the entrance.

Lake Area

One level, handicap parking space is located adjacent to an accessible vault toilet. Terrain to the water's edge is natural turf and contains a short slope of 6 percent before it levels out.

The boat launches and the courtesy dock have not been modified for accessibility.

Trail

The trail is of dirt and in dry weather should be accessible to most visitors as it is quite level.
