Do you know what Missouri's state bird is? Many people think it's the cardinal, but it's actually the eastern bluebird.

Join us in the interpretive center to learn about these vibrantly blue birds and make your own bluebird through the art of needle felting. Needle felting uses special barbed hooks to shape wool into sculptures, and now you can try it for yourself. No felting experience is required, and all materials will be provided.
