## Notes for the Onondaga Scout Patch Program

1. In order to earn the patch, this program must be completed in its entirety during the two-day weekend. No parts can be completed at a later date.

2. Substitution of requirements is not allowed. Special needs will be accommodated, but must be addressed in advance.

3. Reservation of the special use camp is filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Please be aware that there will be mixed ages and genders in the special use camp. "Regular" campsites may be reserved as well using the state park reservation system.

4. There is a limit of 50 total participants. Participants will be chosen on a first-come, first-served basis.

5. This program must be completed by the scout - not the leader or parent. An Onondaga staff member must verify that requirements have been completed and initial requirement sheet.

6. Onondaga Scout Patch Program Requirements: tour one of the show caves and complete the "Cave Quiz" (Note: previous cave tours do not count), hike either the Deer Run Trail or Oak Ridge Trail, attend the Saturday evening program, and complete a pre-determined 3-hour service project

- \* Cathedral Cave Tour \$5.00/Adult and Teen, \$4.00/Child (Note that only one cave is toured during the program.)
- \* Special Use Camping (First-Come, First-Served Basis) \$2.00/person/night
- \* "Regular" Camping (MUST make reservation through State Park Reservation System – park staff CANNOT make reservations for you. There is a limit to 6 people per "regular" campsite and a limit of two sleeping units. To avoid confusion, go to www.mostateparks.com for details.)
  - \* Basic Campsite \$13.00/night
  - \* Electric/Water Campsite \$25.00/night
  - \* Reservation Fee \$8.50/site (non-refundable)
