Dear Governor Greitens and Director Comer:

On behalf of the City Council and Citizens of Rolla Community we want to express our ongoing interest and support of the Rock Island Trail across mid-Missouri. We were encouraged to hear of the acceptance by and construction of the first 47 miles of the Trail by the Department of Natural Resources. The Katy Trail has proven to be a tremendously successful and popular tourist and fitness attraction across MO . . . we see the same potential for the Rock Island Trail.

Like the Katy Trail the Rock Island Trail stands to offer all Missourians (and out-of-state tourists) a tremendous opportunity to enjoy the beautiful outdoor recreational amenities we have in MO. In addition there are a number of small communities along the proposed Trail that stand to benefit from the economic development opportunities of such an asset.
