Visitor Assistance:

- Become familiar with Missouri State Parks camping rules and have each camper sign acknowledging they received a copy of the campground rules
- Notify appropriate personnel (park superintendent, assistant superintendent or park ranger) promptly in the event that campground rules are being disregard. (The campground host is responsible for making patrons aware of the campground rules. ONLY the above personnel are responsible for enforcement.)

Fee Collection:

- Open contact station and collect campground fees, register reserved campers, and sell firewood and ice during designated operation hours
- Verify the identification of individuals on the reserved sites as you process reservation permits and enter them into the system
- Have reservation cards changed and reservations posted by 11 a.m. daily

Light Maintenance:

- Check the vault toilets (3), showerhouse and modern restroom for toilet paper and install rolls as needed. Notify park staff as soon as possible if the facilities do not meet our cleanliness standards.
- Check for trash in campsites and fire pits and dispose of miscellaneous debris properly
- Other duties may include, but are not restricted to, plunging clogged toilets and gathering miscellaneous debris and disposing of it in the appropriate receptacle

Monitor the Campground:

When contact station is closed, inform campers they need to come up during
posted hours to check in and purchase ice and wood. Site to site collection or sale
of wood and ice is not required.
