I. INTRODUCTION

Historic Kansas City Foundation, 201 Wyandotte, Kansas City, Missouri contracted in July 1995 with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources Preservation Program to complete the survey of religious properties in Kansas City, Missouri. The survey project is the third and final phase of identification and evaluation of the city's religious properties in accordance with survey priorities set forth in the City of Kansas City, Missouri's 1992 *Kansas City Survey Plan* and recommendations resulting from *Religious Properties in Kansas City, Missouri*, a survey planning report prepared for the Landmarks Commission of the City of Kansas City, Missouri in 1992 and *An Architectural/Historic Survey of Religious Properties in Kansas City, Missouri*, prepared for Historic Kansas City Foundation in 1994.

These projects and the current project were funded by the State of Missouri, Department of Natural Resources, Division of State Parks, Historic Preservation Program by grants under the provisions of the Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended, from the National Park Service, United States Department of the Interior. Matching funds were provided for the second phase and this phase of survey by Historic Kansas City Foundation, Kansas City Missouri. The contents and opinions, however, do not necessarily reflect the views or policies of the U.S. Department of the Interior or the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.

Objectives of the final phase of the survey of religious properties in Kansas City, Missouri are:

Completion of the comprehensive identification and documentation and potential eligibility for listing on the *National Register of Historic Places* of religious properties in the city limits through intensive level survey of approximately 50 unidentified properties dating prior to 1950 predicted in the 1992 survey plan, and identified in the results of a "windshield survey" conducted as part of the interim phase 1994 survey.

Preparation of a final report analyzing and synthesizing all assembled survey information produced in the current project; in the 1994 survey, *An Architectural/Historic Survey of Religious Properties in Kansas City, Missouri*; in the 1992 survey plan, *Religious Properties of Kansas City, Missouri* and previous survey work dating to the 1950s. Work will include:

confirmation, expansion, modification and/or augmentation of historical contexts as developed as part of the survey plan;

determination of potential eligibility for listing on the *National Register of Historic Places* of all identified religious properties surveyed;

analysis and characterization of identified property types most useful in representing important historic trends and directional patterns;

amendment of architectural nomenclature on previous survey to include terminology consisted with National Register terminology

development of strategies and recommendations for a program to secure National register designation and other protective strategies.

This interim report of the final phase of survey, documents the completion of the identification phase of survey: the identification and documentation and evaluation for potential eligibility for listing on the *National Register of Historic Places* through intensive level survey of approximately 50 properties dating prior to 1950 identified in the 1992 survey plan, *Religious Properties of Kansas City, Missouri* and the results of a "windshield survey" conducted as part of the 1994 survey phase, *An Architectural/Historic Survey of Religious Properties in Kansas City, Missouri*.

II. SCOPE OF INTERIM PROJECT

This phase of the final survey report initially projected the need for intensive level field investigation of approximately fifty (50) selected properties and photo documentation and concurrent archival research on each property. Completion of architectural/historic inventory survey form for each significant or contributing property including floor plans when available. Properties to be surveyed were selected from the properties identified in the 1994 survey phase "windshield survey" and analysis of previous survey effort and city directories. Survey boundaries are located within the 1995 corporate boundaries of the City of Kansas City, Missouri.

III. METHODS

Archival Research

In addition to the documentation provided in the "windshield survey" in the prior phase of survey, methodology concentrated on assembling data on all previous survey to ascertain the location of any other previously unidentified properties. All addresses and names of properties listed in the 1950¹ city directory which related to religious function were entered into a DOS computer data base using the Access software modified for the survey parameters. This data was cross checked with telephone directory information, previous survey data and the properties preliminarily identified in the "windshield survey." Properties which were listed in the 1950 city directory as having associations with African-American groups were also noted. Because previous survey efforts had focused on architectural significance, all listings in the city directories for the years 1870 through 1950 which identified ethnic affiliations either by race or indication of foreign language usage were compiled and

charted in an effort to cross-check previous survey efforts and identify any properties which had been omitted due to lack of architectural integrity/significance and to be used to evaluate changes and patterns in location in the final report.

Prior to field investigation, archival research was conducted at the Kansas City Landmarks Commission as to extant building permits, whether the properties had been included in previous surveys, and current ownership. After field investigation, further research was conducted to provide any additional information regarding the properties. The following research collections were utilized: City of Kansas City, Missouri Landmarks Commission research collection; Jackson County Historical Society Archives & Research Library; Kansas City Missouri Public Library Special Collections; Mid Continent Library - North Branch Local History Collection; and the Historic Kansas City Foundation Research Collection.

Field Survey

Archival research and field investigation identified eleven properties dating prior to 1950 which were thought by virtue of their integrity to warrant documentation on survey forms. Upon submittal to and consultation with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources Historic Preservation Program staff, it was decided that survey forms would be completed on all extant properties with affiliations to ethnic groups, and photo documentation would be provided for all remaining extant properties which retained some evidence of their appearance prior to 1950.

Photography: All of these resources were photo documented utilizing 35 mm black and white film. A negative and a set of black and white 3x5" photograph of each resource will be provided as part of the final report.

Maps: The location of each inventoried property was noted on field maps and later transferred as pinpoint locations on maps of the city. These maps will be merged into one master set of maps containing all locational documentation of all phases of survey which will be provided with the final report.

Site Visits: At least one on-site analysis of each surveyed property was conducted in order to fully assess present condition and integrity of the property. In order to gain access to evaluate and photograph interiors, Historic Kansas City Foundation attempted to contact by phone all of the owners. As of this milestone in the project, access could not be arranged for the properties which are presently occupied. In the large majority of the cases, gaining contact with the owner was not possible.

Completion and Assemblage of Inventory Forms: Completion of the survey forms required additional archival/historical research utilizing primary source materials such as maps and county atlases, building and construction permits, photographic collections and secondary source materials. Using the format of the "Missouri Historic Property Inventory Form" and instructions, a computer generated print-out was provided. The information, which is coded, includes at a minimum, the historic/current names of property, the address, a description of prominent architectural features with emphasis on the primary facade; a documented or estimated date of original construction; identification of obvious alterations/additions; a designation of style or vernacular type, when applicable; identification of architect and/or

builder, if known and an on-site verification and consideration of all applicable information on the form. Each resource was evaluated in accordance with the *Secretary of the Interior's Standards and Guidelines* (Fed. Register Vol. 48, No. 190 pp. 44723-4475) to determine if it has potential for future *National Register* designation.

IV. SURVEY FINDINGS

Seventy properties were identified through preliminary research to be field verified. Of these survey forms were completed on twenty-two buildings. Nineteen additional properties were photographed but, due to integrity issues, were not documented on survey forms. Twenty-five previously unsurveyed buildings had been demolished or destroyed. No chapel or religious facility was found on the Rockhurst College Campus or at St. Teresa's Academy, both are religious sponsored institutions which provide educational offerings to the general public. Unsurveyed buildings predating 1950 at St. Paul's Theological School were found to be administrative/dormitory buildings and not individually significant as a religious building property type. Demolition and new construction on the small campus has seriously impacted the historical integrity of the site and these buildings no longer contribute to a historic setting. And, finally, Westwood Christian Church listed in the 1950 City Directory at 2820 W 53 was located at 5050 Rainbow, outside the city limits.

With the exception of the Little Sisters of the Poor Convent at 5300 Woodland, the twenty-two buildings documented on survey forms were functioned historically either as churches, synagogues, and/or missions. One of these Brown's Tabernacle AME Zion Church, 2101 Vine, originally was designed and functioned as a multiple dwelling and commercial business building. With the exception of the Barry Christian church which dates from the mid-nineteenth century and was undergoing significant alterations, the buildings date from 1900 to 1950.

Architectural Styles

The surveyed properties represent a variety of architectural styles and vernacular types.² and were built of a variety of materials. The surveyed properties were identified as specific architectural styles and/or vernacular types using the "Architectural Style Code" list provided in "the Missouri Historic Property Inventory Form Instructions" as required by the Missouri

²Any vernacular type building can also exhibit elements of a particular architectural style. It is important to note that the term "vernacular type" as used on the Missouri form is differentiated from "property type," as defined by Federal survey guidelines.

Department of Natural Resources and correspond with terminology used in the National Register program. The architectural styles identified in this phase of survey include: Tudor Revival (4), Mission/Spanish Revival (1), Colonial Revival (3) and Classical Revival (1). In addition, the following vernacular types are represented in this survey: Victorian Functional (1), Gabled End (3), Center Steeple (3), Gable Front (2), and Other Vernacular (4). Of these, the following by virtue of their integrity and architectural style are representative examples of their architectural style/design type and have potential for future listing on the National Register either individually or as contributing elements to a district:

St. Augustine Catholic Church (7900 Paseo), c. 1948, embodies distinctive elements of the late Mission/Spanish Revival styling incorporated into a traditional Euro-American church plan.

The integrity of the c. 1947 Classical Revival design of the **Nashua Baptist Church** (11408 N Main Street) provides an excellent example of the refinement and simplification of the style in the post World War II era.

The integrity of the c. 1904 **Bethlehem Antioch Missionary Baptist Church** (3032-34 Montgall) provides an excellent example of the use of Colonial Revival styling for houses of worship.

The size of c. 1926 **Little Sisters of the Poor Convent** (5300-5400 between Woodland and Highland) complex as a distinctive religious property type (group homes/convents/seminaries) and its eclectic use of Colonial Revival stylistic elements contributes to an understanding of the use of historical eclecticism in architecture of this period as applied to specialized property types.

The Tudor Revival style of the c. 1923 **Southpark Christian Church** (5541 Forest) is noteworthy due to the integrity of the building and its ability to communicate nuances of the eclectic local variations of the late nineteenth and early twentieth century revival styles.

The high degree of integrity of the c. 1936 **Winwood United Methodist Church** and use of Tudor Revival styling merits further research as to the building's potential for National Register listing either as an individual building or as a contributing element of a district.

Historical Significance

Three of the buildings are associated with the evolution of suburban development and community planning which occurred in Kansas City after World War I. **Southside Baptist Church** (2914 S 50 Street), c. 1920, may be a contributing element to a National Register District as apart of the suburban development of the "Southside" of Kansas City after World War I. **Nashua Baptist Church**, 11408 N. Main Street may enjoy significance as a contributing element to a district. Nashua was one of Kansas City's earliest planned suburban developments, established in the "Northland" by real estate developer, William Winner in 1892. **Winwood United Methodist Church** (4406 NE 45 Street) was part of the c.

1924 Winwood Community, an early suburban development in Kansas City's "Northland."

Two church buildings have associations with established communities which were later annexed into the boundaries of Kansas City, Missouri. The small crossroads community of the Little Blue is one of the earliest settlements in Jackson County and dates to the 1830s. The congregation of the **Little Blue Baptist Church** (7103 Noland Road) dates to 1832. The c. 1915 house of worship has served, as did its predecessors as a focal point of community life in the area. The c. 1912 **Mt. Olive Baptist Church** (5508 Rolla) is the last remaining structure of the African-American community of White Oak in Clay County. The community dates to 1880s when former slave inherited land from their former owner and established a small crossroads community which functioned until the 1960s.

Ethnic Heritage and Religion

It was expected in the research phase that many of the previously unidentified religious properties would include houses of worship of ethnic groups which had not been previously documented due to their lack of architectural significance. Previous phases of survey examined city directory listings prior to 1943. Between this date and 1950, the arbitrary cut-off date for the entire survey project, there was an increase in the number of African-American congregations and considerable relocation of existing congregations. The following buildings associated with ethnic groups were documented on survey forms:

Two buildings which city directory information indicated had historically housed African-American congregations did not retain sufficient integrity to communicate feelings or associations with the period prior to 1950. The building housing the Willis Church/Good Samaritan Baptist Church, 5337 Bellefontaine, dates to 1962, although the presence of an African-American congregation worshipping at this location as late as 1950. The Gilbert Memorial AME Church, 3704 Topping, was extensively altered in 1960s. While no survey

forms were completed, the buildings were photo documented.

The analysis of significance of these buildings in the larger contexts of importance in ethnic history and religion will be completed as part of the final report. However, during the research to identify previously undocumented buildings, it became apparent that there was considerable mobility of ethnic congregations, many using several locations as houses of worship and many buildings having multiple users. In an effort to bring some clarity to any analysis, it was necessary to chart these trends. This data is included as an appendix to this interim report and will be utilized in the final survey report and recommendations. In addition, mapping of the locational trends will be included in the final report. At this time the information from this survey will be combined with previous survey information and research.
