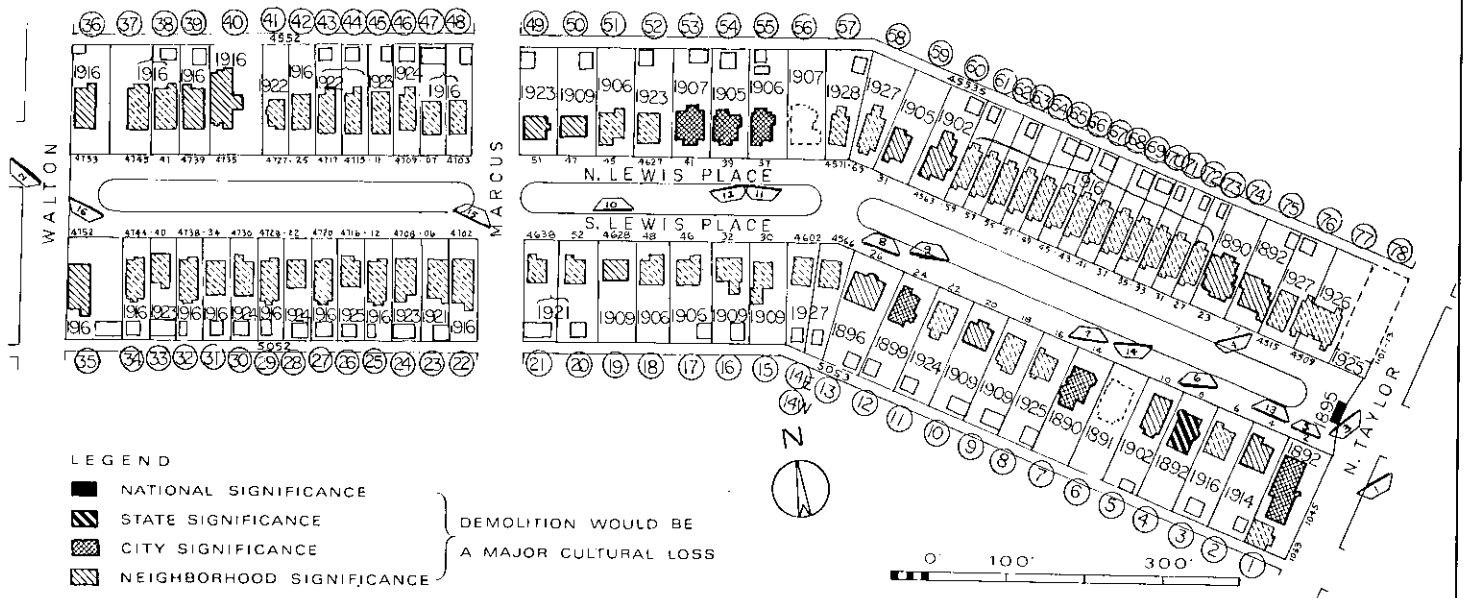


# ARCHITECTURAL SURVEY OF LEWIS PLACE: SITE PLAN
