Flemming may have built this house as late as 1902, when he took out a mortgage of \$5,000 on this property. In 1904 he sold this property for the same amount to Fatima M. Evans. Henry Schulz moved here in 1909 to be closer to his feed and grain business at 60 North Gore, the corner of Marshall Place. His daughter Harriet married James McMillan and built 73 Marshall Place. Schulz was very well known; when his wife died in 1916, all the stores in the area closed on the day of her funeral.


