Arch Cave Expansion Project

Rush Springs Ranch has been awarded a grant from Missouri State Parks through the federal Recreational Trails Program. The project consists of acquisition of 60 acres and construction of 2.77 miles of natural surface multi-use off road trails located at 80 Rush Springs Lane in Pineville, McDonald County, Missouri. A public meeting will be held on July 12, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at the Check-In Shack at 80 Rush Spring Lane in Pineville, MO.

This notice serves to make the public aware of the project and solicit comments pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and the National Environmental Policy Act.
