
## Prairie State Park Public Meeting 2020

# What's at Prairie State Park?




-3955 acres, ~75% never-plowed prairie

-Prairie once covered about 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of state, now <1% remains

-Barton county – 86% prairie, highest historic coverage in MO

Historic tree locations from early19<sup>th</sup> century GLO notes suggests no trees in vicinity of park


# Prairie State Park - Fauna

-50+ bison



# What's at Prairie State Park?




-Over 16 miles of hiking trails



  - Frog/toad calling surveys




# **Maintenance and Repair Projects**
