#43 Mosley probably came to Taney County following the Civil War. He bought the improvements including the reputed 1849 (prob land patent date) saddle bag house. He bought several small tracts assembling a 400% acre spread. Mosley moved the frame house joining it to the saddle bag c.1890s from Huntsman's Mill, after the millman's house had become deserted. The mill ran until C.WWI. This hall and parlor has black walnut siding.


Mosley went to Texas twice in covered wagons to experiment farming there, but always kept Taney Co. land and only stayed for short seasons in Texas. He managed the Hilda mill c.1911-1914.


His large bottom land was a cane brake which was burned to clear cane and timber. Cane never came back, except a few small spots remain.


Tradition states that a Kentucky man came here with family money to buy land for all. He bought but didn't return to Kentucky. His Kentucky kin later came and killed him. Also a Baldknobber threat/incident here, but no one was hurt.



#43. Smith said stock-buying commission men from Springfield came in the valley into the late 1940s. Previously they rode the railroad to Chadwick, hired a hack to go to Taneyville, and hired horses to scout the area. Drives of stock and turkeys went to Chadwick. Drovers all had cow whips, larriat ropes and dogs. After the railroad was terminated they drove cars to the area, but some still hired horese, preferring to buy that way.

Several Braves Creek area families migrated permanently and annually to Wahington state for timber work, but especially for apple orchard work. Peak was apparently in teens and 1920s (I talked to Elmer Morgan who went 13 times to Yakima apple country).
