42. FURTHER DESCRIPTION OF IMPORTANT FEATURES

It is a brick building in a stretcher pattern with arched recessed windows that have a decorative header. The roofline is ornate. The building adjacent on the south was part of the establishment originally but was separated by a stud wall in 1922.

43. HISTORY AND SIGNIFICANCE

The building was commissioned by Arthur Smitt between 1875 & 1883. It has always been used as a retail establishment. The upper floor was used as rental apartments recently but was renovated in 1998 to a single apartment.

44. DESCRIPTION OF ENVIRONMENT AND OUTBUILDINGS

The building is located around the courthouse square in Unionville, MO. The building is adjacent to other buildings of similar architecture, built during the same period of time.

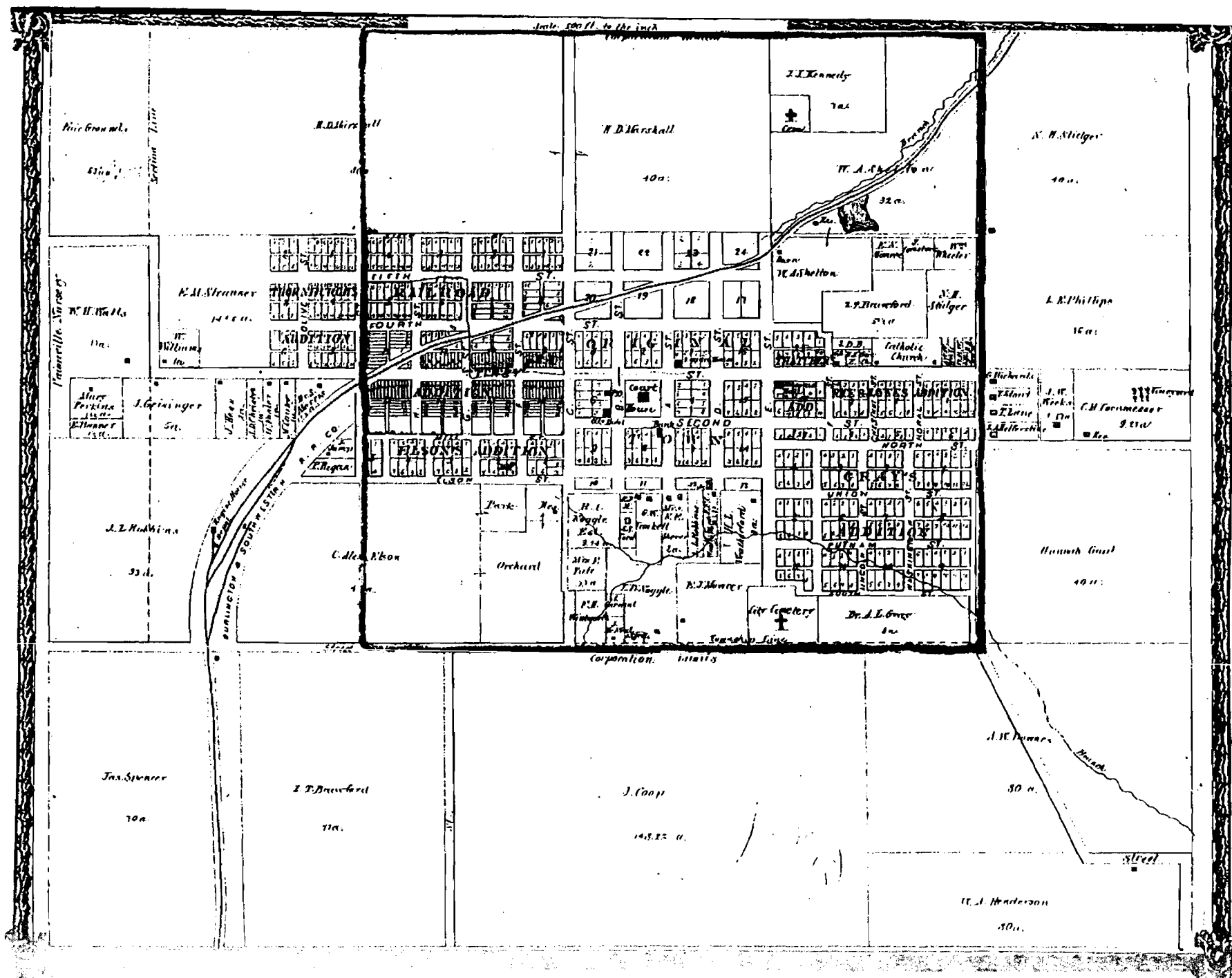
Regarding question #36, the front door to the building was replaced most recently in 1999. The front door area was blocked in for a conventional door (rather than the original double door style entrance) most likely in the 1960's. The windows on the second story and five windows on the first story have been covered with boards. The interior ceilings on the first story have been lowered and the walls have been paneled.

Regarding question #37, the exterior was painted in 1999. The exterior brick was sandblasted in the 1970's. The flat roof has been papered and hot tarred within the last four years. The majority of the interior first floor was recarpeted in 1994 and was paneled most likely in the 1960's. A room in the back of the section of the first floor with access by the front entrance was painted and carpeted in 1999. An unoccupied apartment in back section of the first floor of the building with a separate entrance is in need of repair due to water damage on the paneled walls. The entire second floor, which was likely offices originally and was occupied as apartments until the 1960's is uninhabitable due to water damage and neglect. The building contains a safe which is three levels tall. One level is in the basement, one is on the main floor and one is above the main level safe and still within the first floor area (now above the lowered ceilings). According to pictures, the safe above the main level safe was accessed by stairs and a landing was at this level. The only level with a door remaining on the safe is the main level, although the door is not original.

The building was erected for the purpose of occupancy by the Marshall National Bank. Mr. Hugh D. Marshall had the building erected in 1882. In 1892, the entire West side of the town square burned except for this building. The building was occupied by the bank until 1936 when it was closed. During the 1940's and 1950's, building occupancies included a store that sold one of the first type of washers that had two tubs, one for washing and one for spinning, an embalming room for a local funeral home and an apartment. At one time (dates unknown) the basement was occupied for use as the local telephone exchange. The abstract shows that the property was sold by a liquidating agent of Marshall National Bank to Lloyd W. Norris and Edith L. Norris. The building was occupied by an abstract/title office, an attorney office and an office for a rock quarry in the 1960's. In 1969, the

property was purchased by Don and Frances M. Shuey, the grandparents of the current owner, Samuel Frank, for the purpose of occupancy for an insurance business. The building was then sold to Carlo and Shirley Frank, daughter and son-in-law of the Shueys for continued occupancy in the insurance business. The building is currently occupied by an insurance business and attorney office.

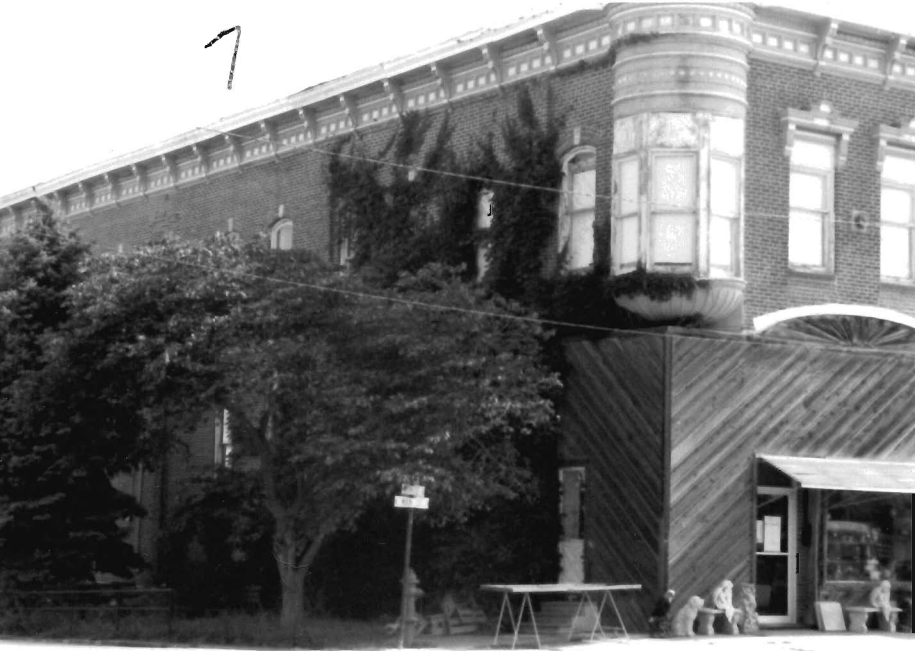
