- Collect camping fees and turn into office by 10 a.m. the next day.
- Greet incoming campground users, give information (pamphlets, brochures, etc.), and answer their questions.
- Sell firewood and turn in money for wood with the camping receipts.
- Pull the expired camping receipts from site post.
- Inform park guests of the camping rules and report any problems to the site administrator.
- Keep the area presentable by picking up litter, replenish toilet paper in restrooms, and report serious maintenance problems to the appropriate park personnel, especially check showerhouse three times on Saturday.
- Do visual inspection of playground for safety and pick up litter around the area.
- Close the gate to the day-use and Lake Road areas at sunset or by 10 p.m. and open and close on Saturdays.

Camp hosts shall be model campers during their period of duty, supporting all rules and regulations of the Division of State Parks and setting a good example for other park patrons. Camp hosts will be provided with a copy of pertinent park rules for their information and guidance.
