- During the months of March and Nov., the park is open from 7 a.m. - 6 p.m. The visitor center is open Sat. and Sun. from 8:30 a.m. - 4 p.m.
- During the winter months, Dec., Jan. and Feb., the park is open from 7 a.m. - 6 p.m. The visitor center is closed during the winter months.
